Living expenses include housing and a choice of three meal plans, all costing the same amount.

Plan II:	Includes any 14 of the 19 meals served per week, plus 100 <i>Bonus Bucks</i> .
Plan III:	Includes any 10 of the 19 meals served per week plus 150 <i>Bonus Bucks</i> .

Payment Plans for the 2011-2012 Academic Year

All amounts owed will be due by the Registration Day for each semester:

Fall 2011 - August 16, 2011

Spring 2012 - January 6, 2012

Commuting and dormitory students have the option of selecting one of the two payment plans.

Payment Plan 1: Payment in full at or before registration.

Pay the amount due on BannerWeb Student Account Summary.

NOTE: One-half of the approved annual award of scholarships, loans or grants may be deducted from the amount owed. Also, first-time students who receive financial aid under the Title IV program are subject to the refund guidelines of that program. Please contact the Office of Financial Aid for specific guidelines.

Payment Plan 2: Set up a payment plan with Tuition Management Systems

MUW has partnered with Tuition Management Systems to give you an alternative to paying the total cost at the beginning of each semester and also to help you lower the amount you have to borrow. We offer annual (10 or 9 payments) and semester (5 or 4 payments) plans. The only cost is an enrollment fee of \$65 for the annual plan and \$46 for the semester plans. There is no interest charges. *****If you make a payment by check, and the check is returned unpaid, there will be an electronic debit of your bank account for the check amount and all (applicable) service fees, taxes and related expenses permitted by law.**

IMPORTANT

Adjustments to tuition and housing expenses are made for students who officially withdraw from the University as follows:

Full Fall and Spring Terms	first 10 days
Accelerated Fall & Spring Terms	first 5 days

Students will be refunded 95% of tuition during these time periods. Students withdrawing from housing during the first 5 weeks of the Fall or Spring semesters will receive a pro rata refund of their housing and meals based on actual occupancy. An additional \$250 contract termination fee will also be added for students who withdraw from housing before the contract period ends.
