After School Program

Afterschool programming three days per week for 11 weeks each semester

Curriculum includes reading, math, character education, leadership, technology, and visual and performing arts

Average class size is 10

Four academic year field trips and Saturdays at MUW Campus Recreation Center

Snacks and transportation provided by project

Space for 100 students

Summer Program

Four week summer programming in June

Opportunities in art for summer 2008 included culinary, dance, pottery, creative writing and mural painting

Leadership and character building programming

MUW Education students work one on one with Crossroads students

Meals and transportation provided by project
