Distance Education Subcommittee Report—Dr. Amber Handy

- The subcommittee met and developed goals for short, medium, and long term.
 - o Short term
 - Determine a common webcam for purchase through the bookstore as a course/lab fee
 - Currently looking into two types that cost between \$15-\$20
 - o Medium term
 - Continue to develop training opportunities for teachers (online and in class)
 - Make steps toward designating hybrid courses in the catalog so that students will know what they are getting into when they sign up for a course
 - o Long term
 - Hire Instructional Designer
 - Continue to develop tutorials for things such as Canvas
 - Develop requirements for online course participation
 - Attempt to create a mandatory laptop policy that would allow students to pick from 3 to 4 options
 - Goal would be for students to be able to use financial aid for this to purchase through the campus bookstore
 - Subgroup of Admissions, Accounting, and Financial Aid is needed to determine how this could work at The W as far as tracking, billing, etc.
 - Determine how to define student contact hours in courses that are taught online
 - Wireless issues should be looked at such as do we have the capacity to handle WiFi for students carrying multiple devices

 - Add a question asking how many wireless devices do students connect with on campus

- Add question asking how many students already own a laptop at the time that they enroll
 - Faculty

 - Add a question asking about instructional technology needs such as new software/hardware needed
 - Add question asking if instructor is primarily an online or in classroom instructor
 - Add question asking what reservations some have about teaching online
