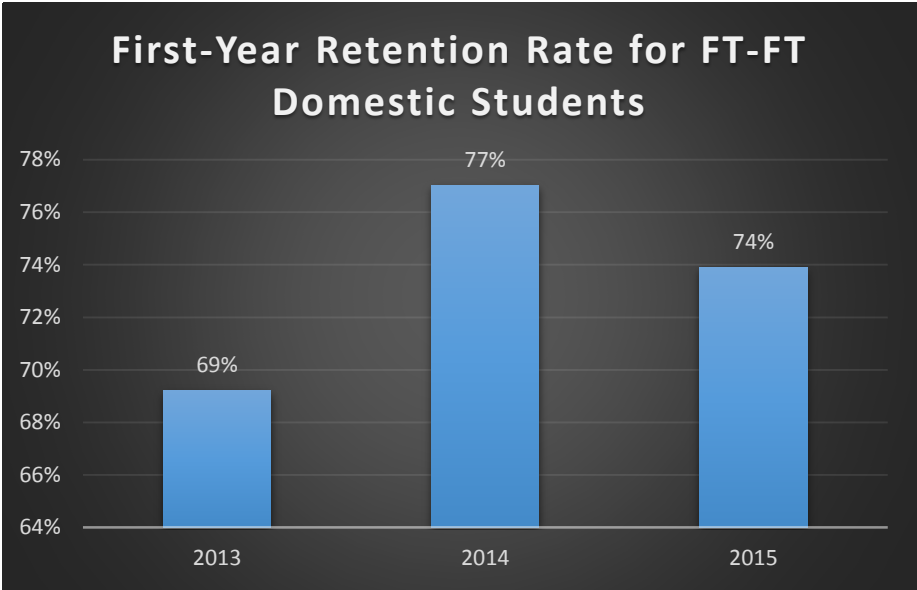




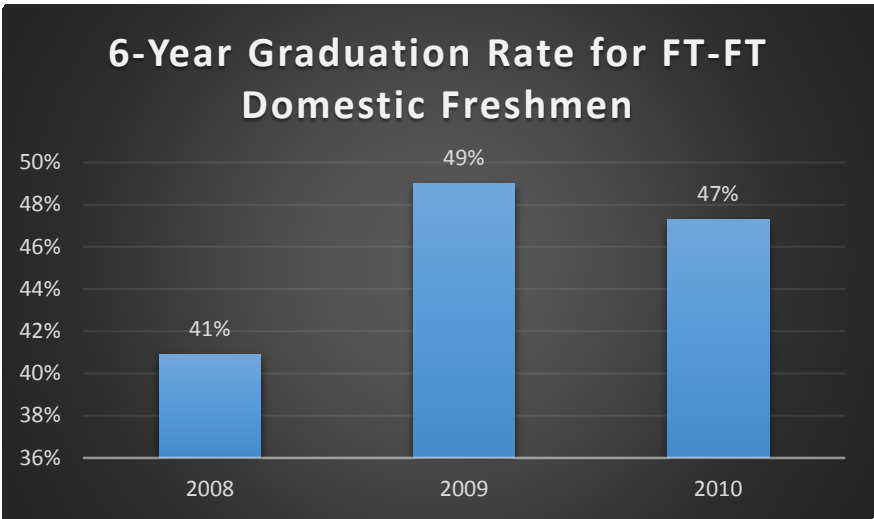

Graduation and Retention

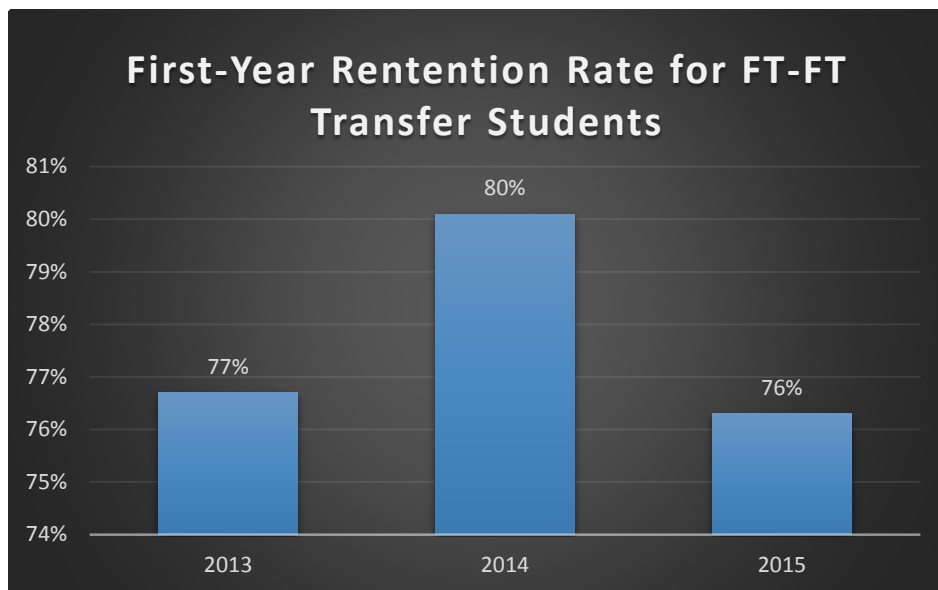
Goal 1: Increase retention of first year domestic students to 80% {Source: Enrollment Management Council}



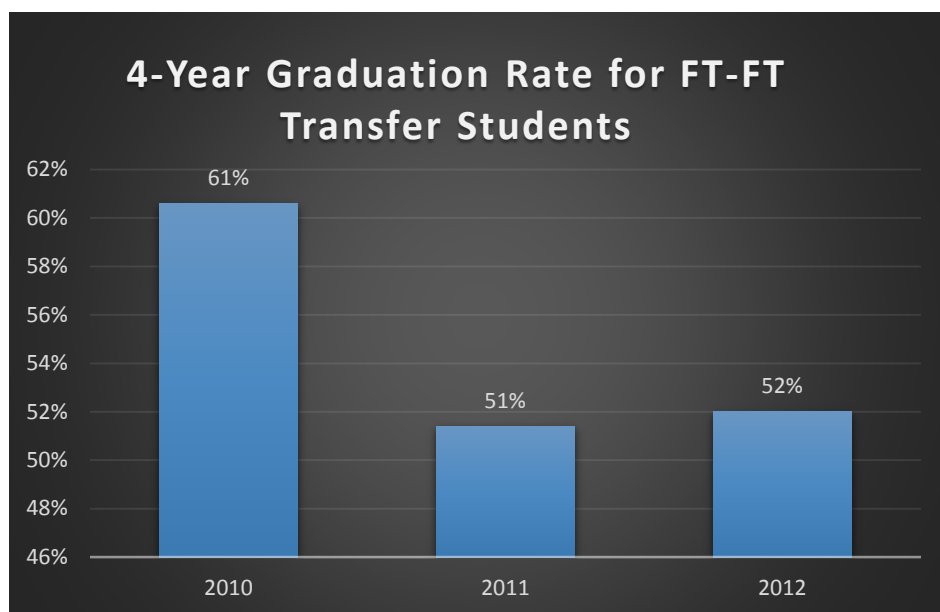
Goal 2: Establish 6-year graduation rate of 45% for First-time Full-time domestic Freshmen {Source: Enrollment Management Council}



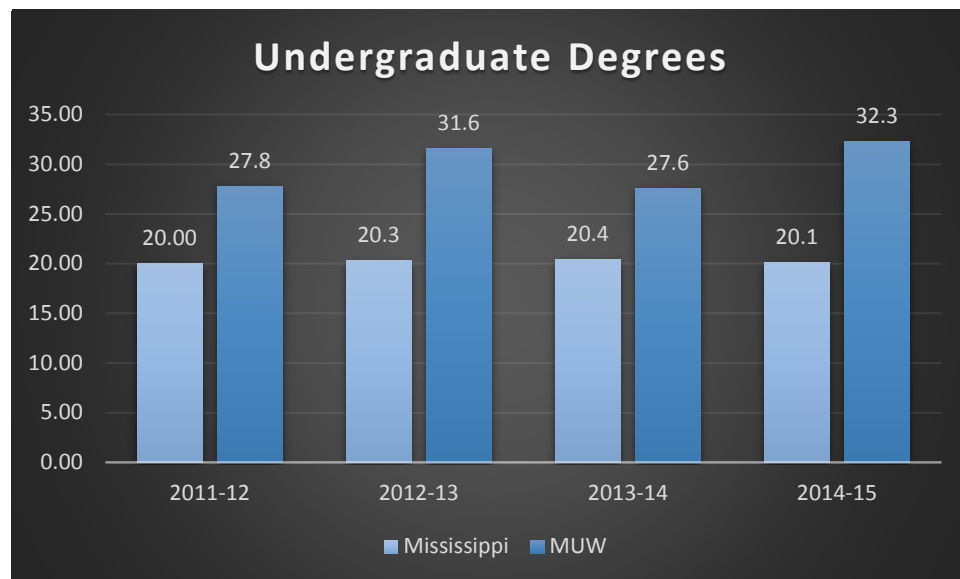
Goal 3: Maintain a first year retention rate 75% or greater for First-time Full-time Transfer Students (*excluding Tupelo Nursing RN to BSN*)

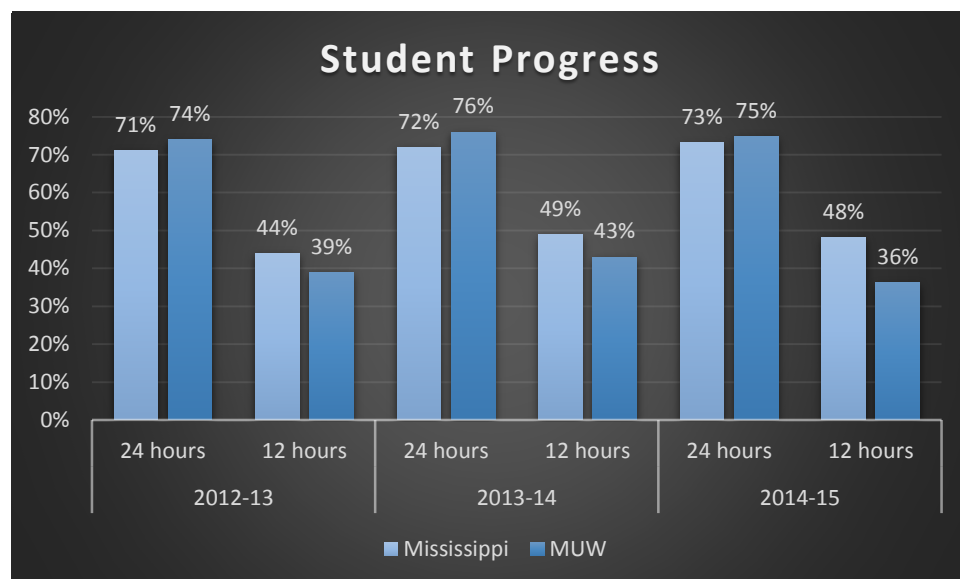

Job Placement

Goal 9: Establish an 85% placement rate of graduates in full-time employment or graduate school within one year of degree completion.

The university's graduates are hired quickly, as evident by the 82% of students who graduated in the 2012-2013 cohort, according to Mississippi Lifetracks data collection on in-state employees. Also, according to the Alumni survey, 74% of participants who graduated in 2014 or 2015 secured full-time employment, and 32% of participants who graduated from 2013 to 2015 have pursued further education in graduate studies.
