**The True W Student Award**  
The True W Student Award will honor an individual who has demonstrated outstanding leadership in promoting campus spirit, pride, introduced a new tradition or innovative idea to promote campus life, and/or the University's prestige, and exemplify loyalty to The W—a true "W student", while also maintaining strong academic excellence.

**Outstanding Minority Award**  
The Outstanding Minority Award celebrates the works/merits of a minority student leader on campus, who promotes diversity, unity, and acceptance by educating the student body about their minority population through programming and other means, while also maintaining strong academic excellence. Minority is defined as being a member of any underrepresented population.
