

# **Campus Recreation Membership Categories**

## **PRIMARY MEMBERSHIPS**

Primary members are defined as individuals (student, faculty, staff, alumni and retiree) eligible to purchase a Campus Recreation membership based on their affiliation with Mississippi University for Women.

### ***Student***

Currently enrolled undergraduate and graduate students at Mississippi University for Women are free to use Campus Recreation programs and facilities through payment of tuition. Students will use the official MUW Student ID for access to programs and facilities.

Students may purchase any of the memberships in the “sponsored memberships” category. Sponsored members of students may participate in all programs except for the Intramural Sports program and cannot hold a membership longer than the primary member.

### ***Faculty/Staff***

All regular MUW full-time and part-time employees who are “benefits eligible” and Sodexo/Folette employees are eligible for a free Campus Recreation membership and have access to all facilities and programs. Eligibility will be confirmed with Human Resources. The members will use the official MUW Faculty/Staff ID for access to programs and facilities. Membership must be activated through the Office of Campus Recreation.

“Non-benefits eligible” (temporary, part-time, adjunct, or visiting faculty/staff) may purchase a Campus Recreation membership on a semester basis upon confirmation of status. This group is not eligible for payroll deduction.

All faculty/staff members may purchase any of the memberships in the “sponsored memberships” category. A sponsored member may not hold a membership longer than the primary member.

Faculty/staff and their spouse/significant other may participate in all Campus Recreation programs. Sponsored members of faculty/staff may participate in all programs except for the Intramural Sports program.

### ***Alumni***

Individuals who have graduated from Mississippi University for Women are eligible to purchase a membership to Campus Recreation.

Alumni members may purchase any of the memberships in the “sponsored memberships” category. The sponsored member may not hold a membership longer than the primary member. Alumni members and their sponsored members may participate in all Campus Recreation programs except Intramural Sports.

Upon application and verification of eligibility, members will receive a Campus Recreation photo ID card. This ID must be used for admittance to all facilities/programs.

Alumni memberships may be purchased on a semester or annual basis.

### ***Retirees/Widowers***

A former MUW employee with emeritus status or official designation as a retired employee is eligible to purchase a primary Campus Recreation membership. Widowers of retirees are also eligible to purchase a membership at the retiree rate.

Retirees or widowers of retirees may purchase any of the memberships in the “sponsored memberships” category. The sponsored member may not hold a membership longer than the primary member. Retiree/Widower members and their sponsored members may participate in all Campus Recreation programs except Intramural Sports. A Campus Recreation photo ID will be issued to members upon completion of application and verification of eligibility. This ID must be used for admittance to facilities/programs.

Retiree/Widower memberships may be purchased on a semester or annual basis.

## **SPONSORED MEMBERSHIPS**

Primary members may sponsor the following additional memberships: spouse/significant other, family, adult family member, daily guests, child pool pass, and Pay to Play. Sponsored member may not hold a membership longer than the primary member. To enroll a sponsored member, the primary member must be present at the time of enrollment. A primary membership purchase is required, except for Faculty/Staff, to sponsor any of the following categories:

### ***Spouse/Significant Other***

Spouse/Significant other relationships must be verifiable by any of the following means: same last name, same address (proof through checking, utility bill or state ID), or financial co-dependency (joint checking or savings account, shared lease or mortgage). The term “significant other” does not imply spouse benefits outside of Campus Recreation membership.

### ***Family***

A Family Membership permits one additional adult and all children under the age of 22 residing in the same household with the primary member.

### ***Adult Family Member***

A primary member may sponsor two (2) additional adult family members living in the same household. This relationship must be verifiable by any of the following means: same last name, same address (proof through checking account, utility bill or state ID), or financial co-dependency (joint checking/savings account, shared lease or mortgage).

### ***Child Pool Pass (annual pass)***

A primary member may purchase a “child pool only pass” for each child under the age of 12, living in the same household. Access is restricted to the locker rooms and swimming pools only. A primary membership **MUST** be purchased to sponsor this membership. Age restrictions/requirements for the pool area must also be met.

### ***Pay to Play***

A “Pay to Play” membership provides the cardholder 20 visits to the Stark Recreation Center any time the facility is open. The primary member can sponsor up to two (2) “Pay to Play” member at a time. The primary user must be present when the “Pay to Play” membership is purchased. Pay to Play members do not have any additional sponsorship privileges.

### ***Daily Guest Pass***

Daily guests must be sponsored by a valid MUW student or eligible Campus Recreation membership card holders. Sponsors must accompany daily guests during their entire visit to the facility and are limited to 3 guests per visit. Guests may not check-out equipment. Sponsors are responsible for their guest’s actions while using Campus Recreation facilities/programs.

## **SPECIAL MEMBERSHIPS**

### ***Community Members (limited to 50 memberships)***

Anyone who does not have an affiliation with the university through other membership categories may purchase a single membership to Campus Recreation. This is an annual membership good for one (1) year from the date of purchase. Community members may sponsor a daily guest but do not have family/spouse sponsorship privileges. Members may participate in all Campus Recreation programs except Intramural Sports. A Campus Recreation photo ID will be issued to member upon completion of application and must be used for admittance to all facilities/programs.

### ***Recent Alumni***

Upon graduation from MUW, the graduate can purchase a “Recent Alumni Membership” for the semester immediately following graduation. This is available for one (1) semester only. Recent alumni members may participate in all Campus Recreation programs except Intramural Sports.

A Campus Recreation photo ID will be issued to members upon completion of application and verification of eligibility. This ID must be used for admittance to all facilities/programs.

### ***Breakfast Club***

Any person eligible for a primary membership, including Community members, may purchase a “Breakfast Club” membership at a reduced rate. The member’s usage of the Stark Recreation Center is restricted to mornings (6am – 12 noon, Monday – Fridays) and anytime on weekends and during the semester breaks.

### ***Summer Pool Only***

Individuals eligible for primary membership may purchase this membership for themselves, spouse or family. This membership is good from May 1 – August 31 and allows access strictly to the swimming pool area. Pool Only members may sponsor daily guest passes.

### ***Summer Continuing Student***

Current students who are not enrolled for either summer term may purchase a summer membership provided they are enrolled for the next fall semester. Continuing students may sponsor daily guest and Pay to Play memberships.

### ***Conference Pass***

University departments/programs that host a conference/workshop on campus can make arrangements for attendees to use the Stark Recreation Center. Contact the Office of Campus Recreation for more details.

The Office of Campus Recreation reserves the right to terminate any membership and guest privileges for failure to abide by the set policies and procedures or misuse of facilities and equipment.
