Payment for Summer 2026

Payment plans will be available through CashNet and will consist of 3 equal monthly payments due on May 15th, June 15th and July 15th.

A \$50.00 enrollment fee will apply to all payment plans.

If you choose not to use a payment plan, the following due dates will apply:

Full & 1st Accelerated Term - 1/2 of the total charges is due on Registration Day, May 18, 2026.

The remainder is due June 15, 2026.

2nd Accelerated Term - The total charges are due on Registration Day, June 22, 2026.

*****If you make a payment by check and the check is returned unpaid, the check will be charged back to your student account and a returned check fee of \$20.00 will be applied additionally.**
