 - Resume
- Submit application documents via email to Elise Wilson at jewilson@muw.edu
- Top applicants will be invited to interview with CSPD staff

Scholarship Program Requirements:

- Enrollment in LDR 399 – Career Readiness through Emotional Intelligence for Fall 2024
- Involvement in campus organizations
- Attend a minimum of one Professional Development Workshop per semester
- Be a Student Ambassador for CSPD
- Meet with CSPD staff 8 – 10 times a semester to discuss case studies relevant to career readiness competencies
- Complete Professional Development Certification Program throughout time at MUW
- Access to preferred internships
