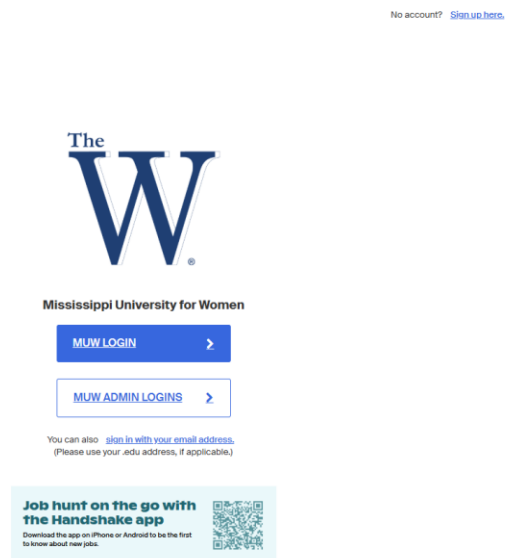
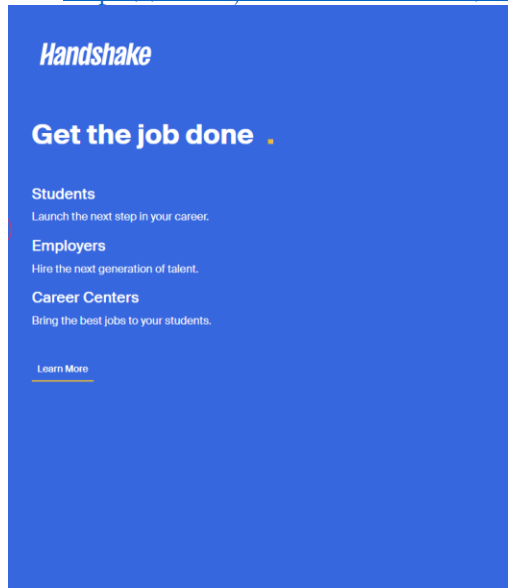


Activating Students' Handshake Accounts

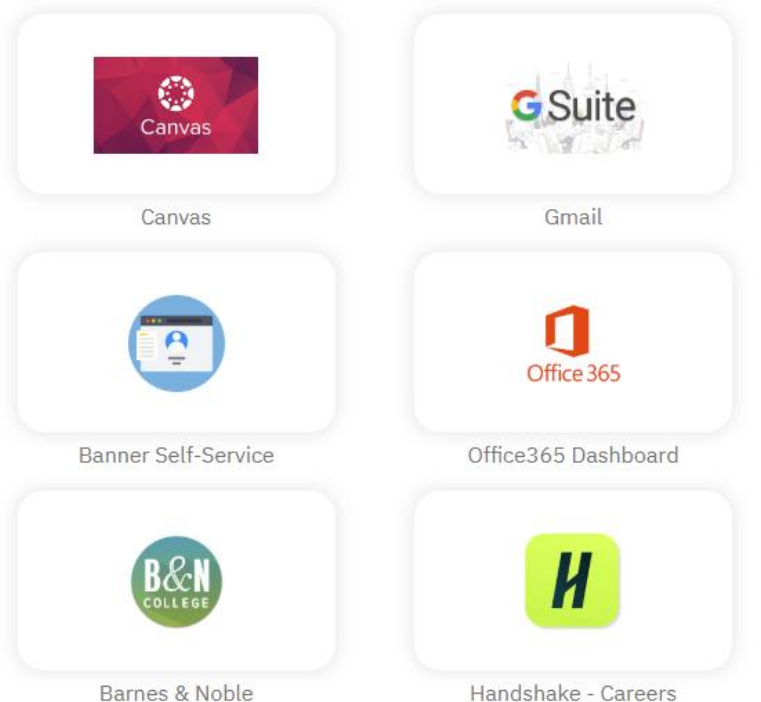

1. Visit <https://muw.joinhandshake.com/login>.

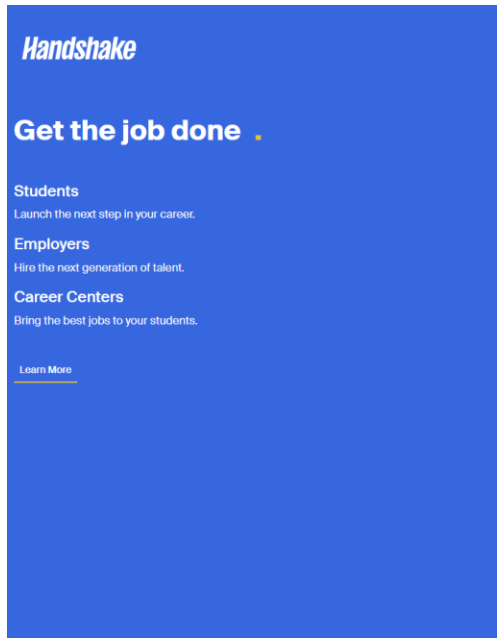

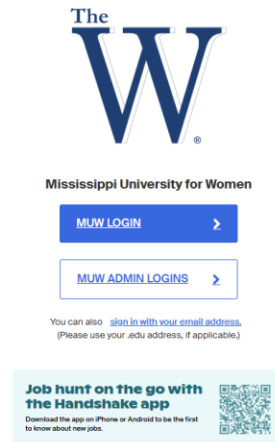

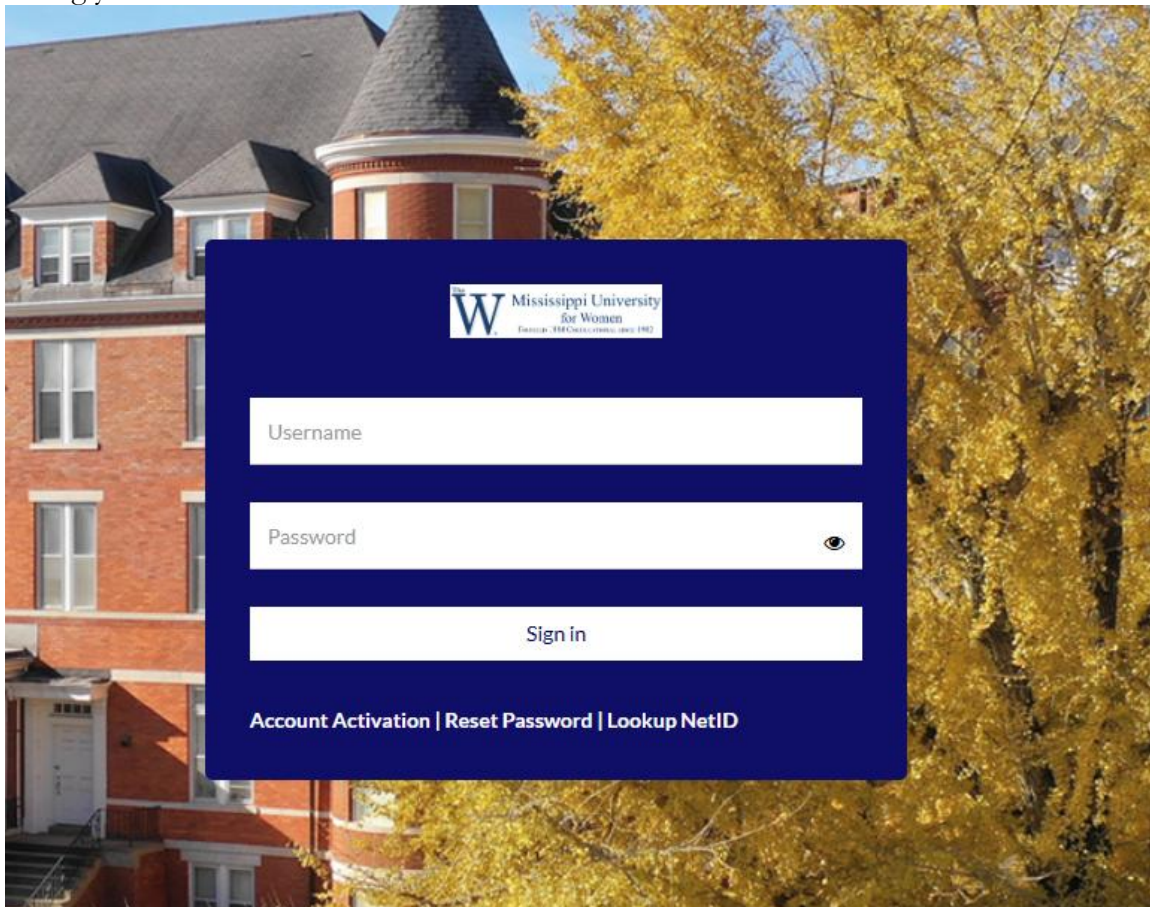
2. Click the blue MUW LOGIN button.
