- a resume
- 3 letters of recommendation
- a passing score on an approved Praxis II Subject Area exam (can be admitted conditionally without this; speak to an advisor for details)

Pass both sections of ED 697 (other courses can be taken concurrently).

Obtain Class A, 5-year, renewable MS Educator License.

Pass remaining MAT courses.

Obtain Class AA, 5-year, renewable MS Educator License.
