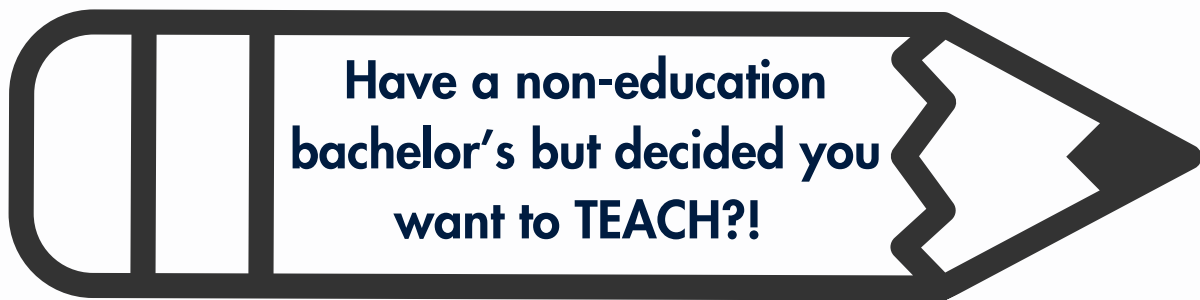

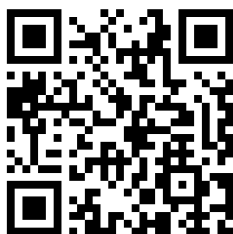
What Do I Need to Apply?

- a resume
- 3 letters of recommendation
- a passing score on an approved Praxis II Subject Area exam (can be admitted conditionally without this; speak to an advisor for details)



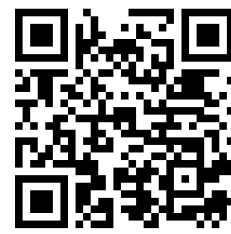
