**General Requirements:**

1. Courses used to satisfy the University General Education Curriculum may not be applied to a Focus Group or the University Studies Core.
2. A course may not be used to satisfy both a Focus Group requirement and a University Studies Core requirement.
3. A course may not be used to satisfy requirements of two Focus Groups.
4. At least one-quarter of the total degree hours required must be earned at MUW and one-quarter must be earned at a four-year institution
5. Any course being used to satisfy either a Focus Group requirement or University Studies Core requirement may not be used to satisfy another minor or major.

<b>Option 1:</b> Complete a minimum of 30 hours in one of the following focus groups. A minimum of 18 hours must be at the 300 level or higher.
<b>Option 2:</b> Complete a minimum of 15 hours in two of the following focus groups. A minimum of 9 hours in each of the focus groups must be at the 300 level or higher.
<b>Option 3:</b> Complete a minimum of 10 hours in three of the following focus groups. A minimum of 6 hours in each of the focus groups must be at the 300 level or higher.
