Eligibility

Students must be (at least) juniors to be eligible to apply. They must also have at least one semester to complete at MUW before graduation (so that they may be active participants in the organization) as well as a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher.

How to Apply

This year's application forms are due by 5 pm Friday, April 2 and may be submitted either electronically (email as an attachment to cerainey@muw.edu) or in person to Dr. Chanley Rainey, the Mortar Board sponsor (slip it under the door of Room 202 in Painter Hall before campus closes on Thursday, April 1).

National dues for Mortar Board are \$80.00 and local dues are \$40.00. This is a one-time payment, not a yearly one. Dues must be paid by initiation, which is in Cochran Ballroom at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, April 12th. The dues may either be in cash (you will be provided with a receipt) or paid by check to MUW Mortar Board and must be submitted to Dr. Chanley Rainey (Office 202 in Painter Hall).
