This statistical report contains data which provide insight into the operation of the public universities in Mississippi during the summer of 1982 and the 1982-83 Regular Session. It contains the primary measures of academic production: enrollments, classes, student credit hours, and degrees awarded. It also contains the revenues and expenditures for the eight universities in Mississippi.

Enrollments are shown by semester or quarter, on-campus or off-campus. The enrollments are depicted by full-time and part-time, school/division, resident and non-resident, and full-time equivalent. Extension class enrollments are reported as enrollees in class.

The student credit hour production is classified into fields of study according to the Higher Education General Information Survey (HEGIS) Taxonomy. The student credit hours are shown according to class levels, oncampus and off-campus, and regular session and summer session. These data are matched with the actual investments for 1982-83 in determining the cost per student credit hour to be used in the "formula" calculation of the state appropriation requests.

This publication also shows the number of degrees awarded from July 1, 1982, through June 30, 1983. These are broken down by baccalaureate, master's, specialist and sixth year, and doctoral degree programs according to the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) system. Associate degrees and certificates awarded during the same period are displayed as well.

Actual revenues received during the fiscal year are reported according to source of income from restricted and unrestricted funds, and the percents of each source derived from total Education and General income are shown in the report.

Information regarding actual expenditures for restricted and unrestricted purposes is reported according to functions. The investment per student credit hour for instruction has been derived using only expenditures of unrestricted current General Funds. The data depicting investment per student credit hour by instruction have been classified in the academic fields listed by HEGIS.

Data reflecting student credit hour investment for instruction are used to determine the rate per student credit hour in 1982-83. This rate, applied by groups to the total production of an institution for the year 1982-83, forms the base for the allocation of state appropriations to each institution for fiscal year 1985.

Statistics for the year 1982-83 are available in other publications of the Board of Trustees. The January, 1983, statistical report includes information about enrollment, residence, and dormitory utilization for the first term only of 1982-83. Scholarships and financial aid awarded are also shown in the same publication.


