

This statistical report contains a collection of data which gives insight into the operation of the public senior universities in Mississippi during the 1986-87 fall session. The report is a combination of various data such as enrollments, residence hall (dormitory) and classroom utilization, faculty information, student aid, student fees, and library needs and expenditures.

The information on enrollment includes 1986-87 first session registration of students. The data are shown by on-campus and off-campus. The enrollments are given by classes, sex, residence, programs, degree level, and full-time-equivalent.

The section on Scholarships and Financial Aids for 1986-87 included in this publication shows the number of awards and the number of awards by amount of assistance. The number of individuals involved is given by both the scholarships and financial aids provided during fiscal year 1986.

Data relating to detailed budget analysis are available in other publications by the Board of Trustees.
