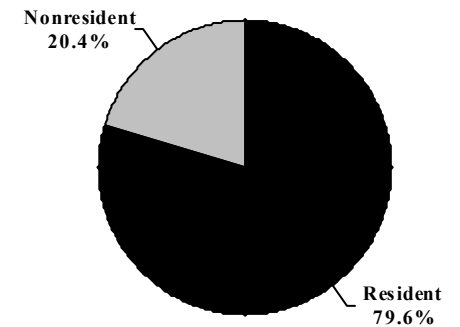
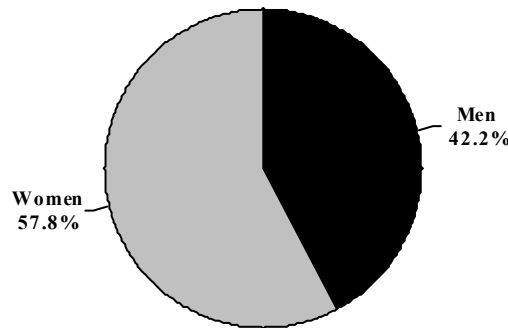
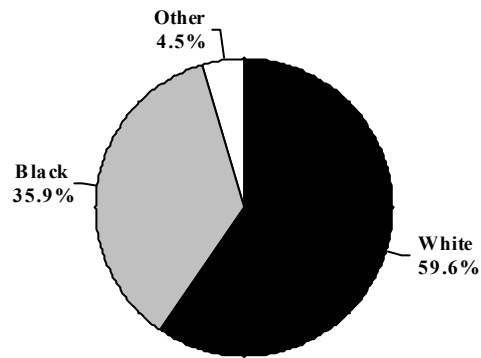


Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment



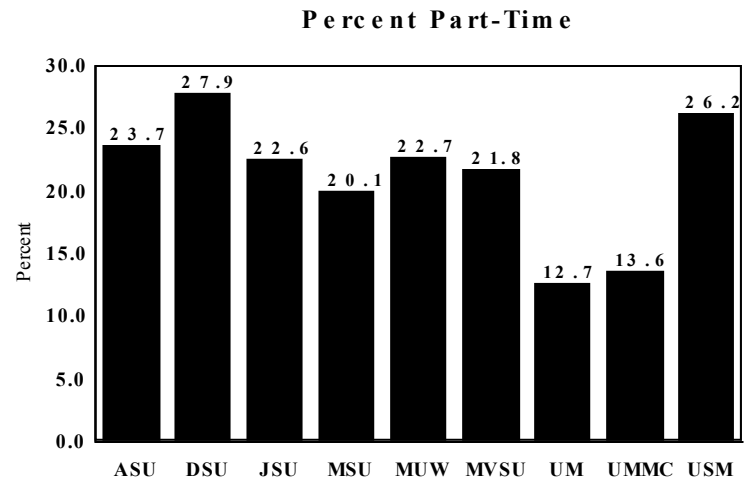
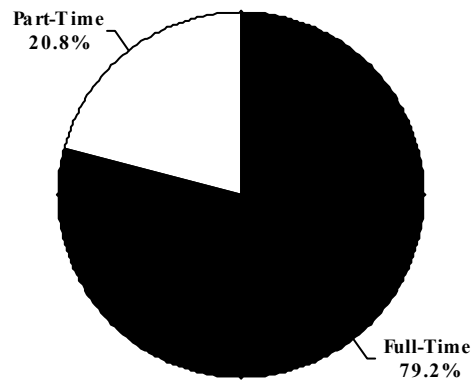

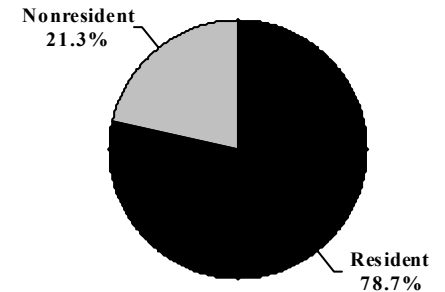
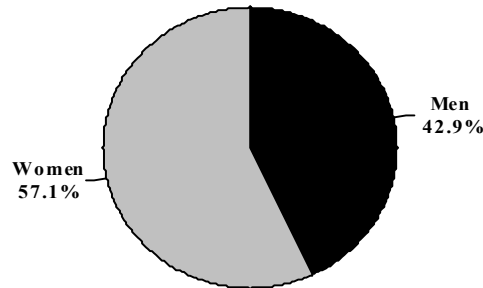
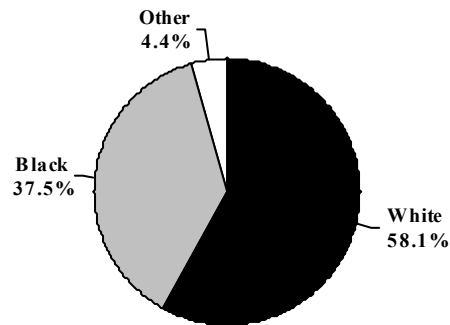


Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment



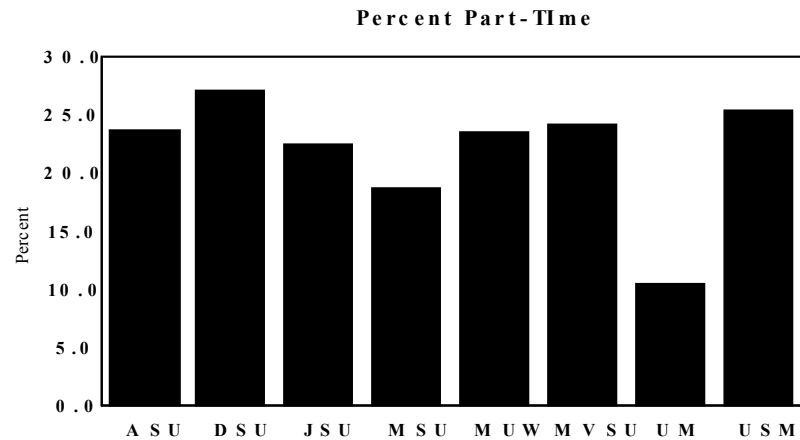
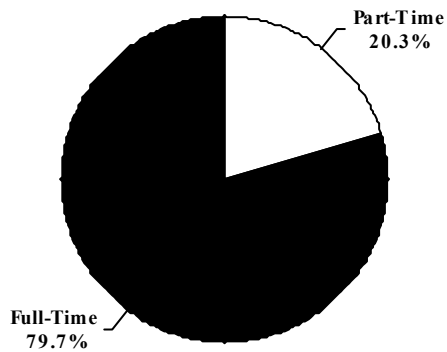

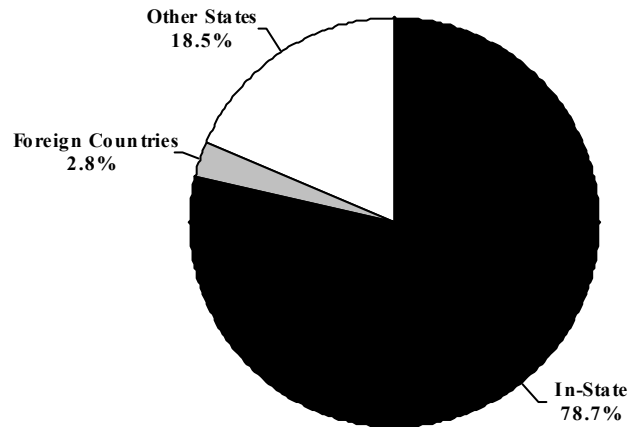


DISTRIBUTION OF ACT COMPOSITE SCORES

Percent of Undergraduate Enrollment



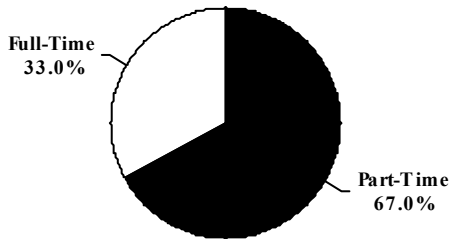

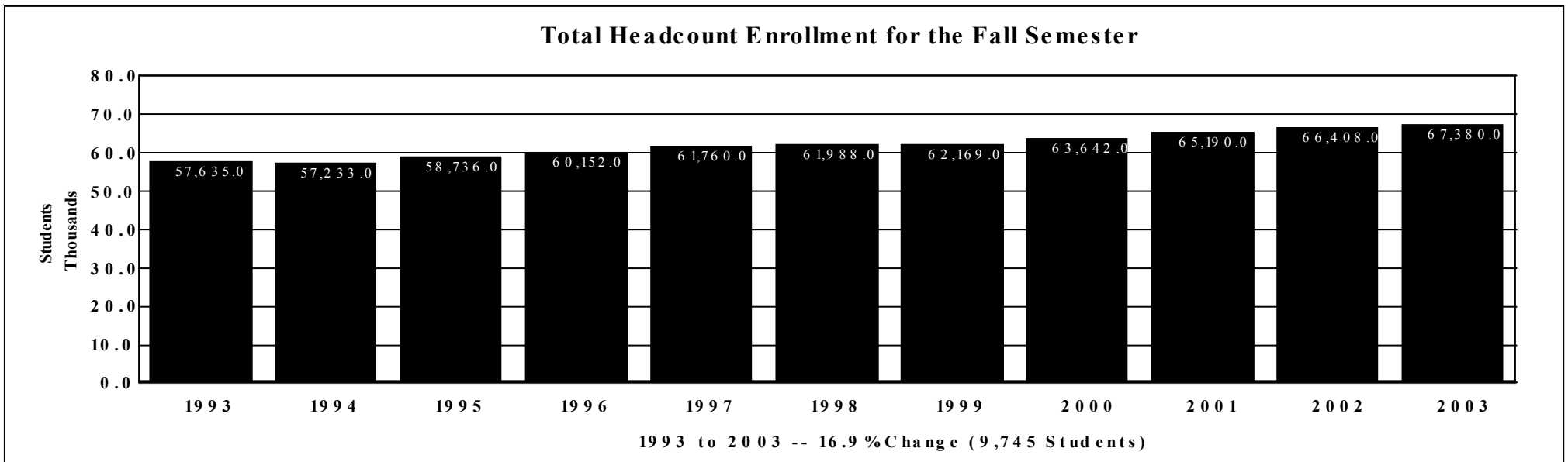

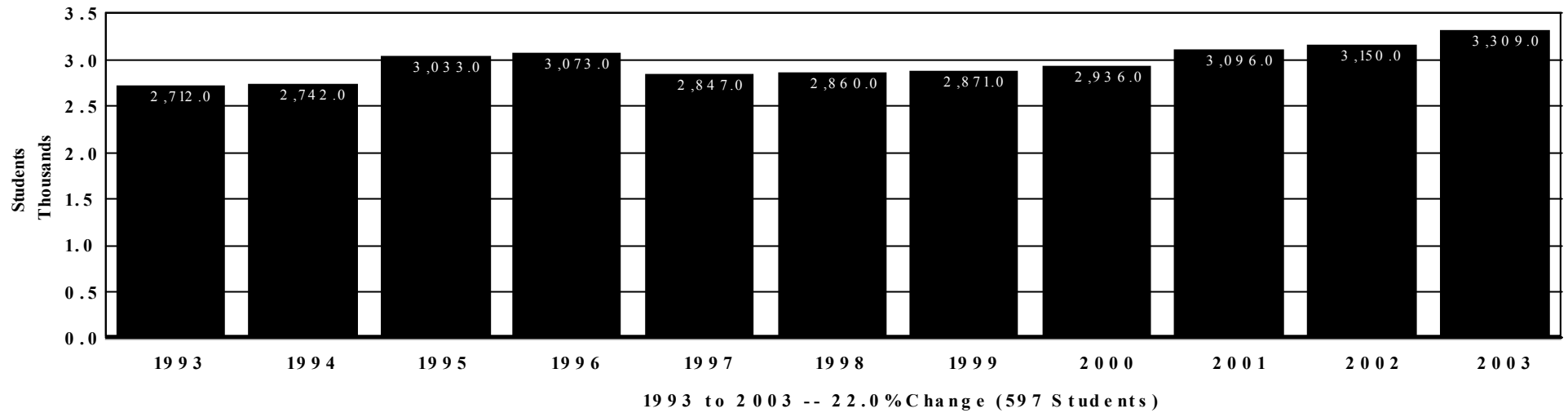
