



#### Q2 - Indicate your major field of study.






# Q3 - Indicate the Academic Year in which your degree was conferred.



# Q5 - When were you offered your first full-time position after your recent MUW graduation?











## Q16 - What is your race? (Select all that apply.)








# Q20 - Are you a member of the Alumni Association?






