When you don't know your NetID:

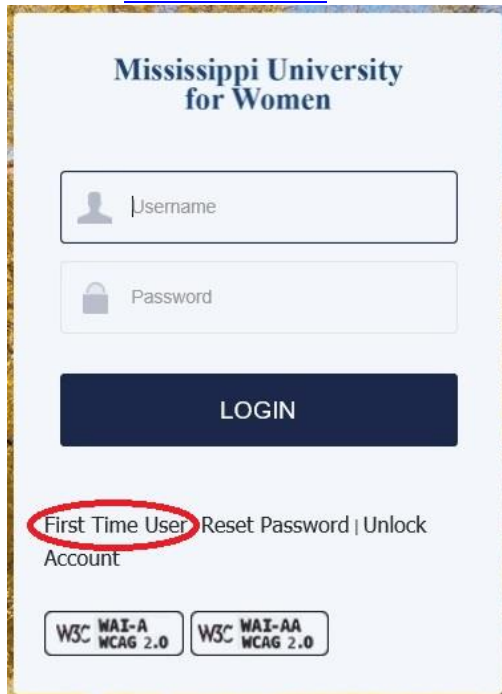
1. Go to www.muw.edu.
2. Click on [Banner](#) at the top right, but don't log in.
3. Click on "Look Up MUW ID and MUW Net ID".
4. Fill in the information and click continue.
5. Write down your MUW ID and your MUW NetID.

When you know your NetID:

1. Go to www.muw.edu.
2. Click on [WCONNECT](#) at the top right, but don't log in.



3. Click on [First Time User](#) at the bottom

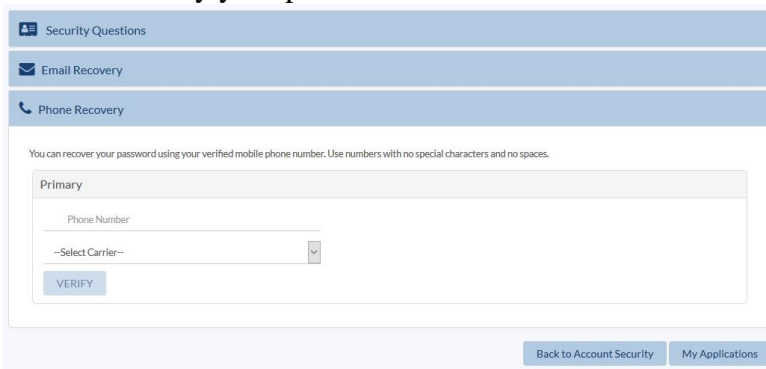
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11. Enter and verify your personal email address
