**Administrative/Biographical Notes:** Nellie Sutton Keirn, originally from Lexington, Mississippi, was hired in 1906 as a teaching fellow at the college following her graduation from the II&C. Due to President Whitfield's encouragement, she took a year's leave to earn a master's degree at the University of Wisconsin. Upon her return in 1912, she became an assistant in psychology and education and a professor of geography. In 1919, president Whitfield appointed her as dean, and later in 1925, President Fant named her vice-president. Upon Fant's death in November 1929, Governor Bilbo asked Keirn to serve as acting president, and she agreed while making it clear that she did not seek the position permanently. Having been familiar with Fant's plans for the college, she set out to achieve his vision, making requests to the legislature in 1930 for necessary funding as well as operating a competitive summer school at the college. Despite the efforts of female faculty like Lena Vaughn to promote Keirn as a candidate for permanent presidency, Keirn made it clear to the Board of Trustees that she did not seek the position. In an unexpected decision from the board - prompted by Governor Bilbo's political maneuvering - Keirn was dismissed from the college altogether in 1930. She left for two years, but returned in 1932 and was reappointed as dean. She retired in 1955, during President Hogarth's administration, having worked for the college for nearly 50 years.

Clytee Evans served as dean in Keirn's absence, beginning in 1930. She was an alumna of the college, and was completing her doctorate while serving as head of the biology department at the University of Chicago when President Sutherland made the request. She returned to teaching in the biology department upon Keirn's return in 1932.

Other deans of students include: M. J. S. Callaway, who served as "lady principal" at the II&C, the approximate equivalent of dean of students; Nellie Keirn (1919-1955), Clytee Evans (1930-1932), Marguerite Goen (1956-1963), Margaret Jameson (1964-1966), Claire F. Wall (1967-1968), Ann Brooks McAllister (1969-1972, 1974-1977), Linda Dye (acting 1973), Gloria Raines (1978). Dean Raines was simultaneously elevated to Vice President of Student Affairs in 1978, and it seems that the two offices were merged from then on. The next official "Dean of Students" was Sirena Cantrell who began serving as interim dean in September 2013. Cantrell was officially named Dean of Students in July of 2014.



The jobs description of the Dean of students typically included general student affairs, admissions, schedules, disciplinary actions, budgets, reports, etc. The office handled a range of administrative tasks, and changed over time as new positions were created at MUW.

**Scope and Content Notes:** The collection includes transcripts, reports, budgets, excuses, schedules, etc. Also, when Nellie Keirn became acting president in 1929, her files also included faculty administration and letters to the state legislators in addition to the material.

**System of Arrangement:** Boxes C12 – C26 (Dean of Students Records from Nellie Keirn and Clytee Evans) are arranged chronologically, with the exception of box C12. The remainder, boxes C397, C156, C433, C434, C397, C398, C399, C400, C99, C210, C211, and C448 are arranged alphabetically.

**Conditions Governing Access:** Boxes C398 and C399 contain student records and are not open for research use. They will be unsealed in the year 2049.

Permission to publish or reproduce must be requested in writing to the University Archivist.
