Earlier today, an off-campus individual was apprehended by The W Police Department and Columbus Police Department.

At 8:21 a.m., a resident advisor from the Mississippi School for Mathematics and Science reported a male exposing himself to students behind Fant Memorial Library. After being approached and searched by officers, the suspect fled from campus. The individual did not pose a threat to campus and will be charged by The W Police Department with indecent exposure, false information and resisting arrest. Joshua Elijah Hargrove, age 21, was arrested at 8:50 a.m. Hargrove has been banned from campus.
