OPERATING DETAILS:

1. The Undergraduate Research Advisory Committee is a standing committee responsible for facilitating and promoting undergraduate research, supporting faculty mentoring of undergraduate research, and creating research opportunities through on-campus and off-campus partnerships.
2. The committee is composed of one faculty member from the following disciplines: Humanities, Sciences/Mathematics, Social/Human Sciences, Fine Arts, Nursing, Non-nursing Health Sciences (Speech-Language Pathology or Health and Kinesiology), Business, Professional Studies (Culinary or Legal Studies) and Education, as well as 1-3 students selected by the committee. Ex-officio members include the Director of the Ina E. Gordy Honors College and Coordinator of Undergraduate Research who serves as the chair and library representative of this committee.
3. Committee members serve in two-year appointments, with one-half of a college's representation rotating off every year, thus staggering rotations. If a faculty who is due to rotate off wishes to remain on the committee, and the dean of the college approves, they may opt to do so.
4. The committee supports planning, marketing, and operating the undergraduate research symposium.
5. The committee serves as an advisory board for campus initiatives to support undergraduate research.
