In other words, The W is nationally respected but locally under appreciated.

This pattern weakens the very return on investment that national rankings celebrate. Mississippi taxpayers already receive extraordinary value from The W's performance — the challenge now is ensuring that value is not taken for granted.

Mississippi has in The W a proven, high-performing public university that:

- Trains a large share of the state's healthcare workforce.
