OPERATING DETAILS:

- 1. Voting members of the Honors College Committee include twelve faculty members appointed by the Chief Academic Officer in consultation with the Academic Deans and the Honors Director. At least one faculty member comes from each College/School. The Library's liaison to the Honors College and the president of the Honors Student Council serve as ex-officio members.
- 2. The Honors College Committee advises the Director of the Honors College, the Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs, and the Chief Academic Officer about the policies, curriculum, and direction of the Honors College.
- 3. Voting members of the Honors College Committee also (a) serve as honors readers on students' honors research project committees, (b) evaluate the presentations of the completed projects at the Research Symposium each semester, (c) participate in interviews with applicants to the Residential Honors Program, and (d) assist the Director of the Honors College in making decisions about honors students' academic and Honors College scholarship appeals. Voting members will serve an initial two-year term. If a faculty who is due to rotate off wishes to remain on the committee, and the dean of their college approves, they may opt to do so.
